Daily Reading—

Maths

This half term we will:

- ⇒ Column addition and subtraction
- ⇒ Place Value
- ⇒ Times tables
- ⇒ Problem solving

You could help your child at home by learning their TIMES TABLES and knowing the corresponding division facts. All children in year 4 must know their times tables (up to 12)

English

This half term we will:

- ⇒ Look at stories with a historical setting
- ⇒ Non chronological reports

You could help your child at home by learning their spelling and making sure they read over their work ensuring all

sentences make sense.

Daily reading (at least 10 minutes a day)

Science

Animals Including Human

- Understanding the functions of digestive systems for animals and humans.
- Learning about how food is digested and used for energy.
- Knowing the names of different organs in the digestive system.
- Knowing and understanding the role for different types of teeth.

You could help your child at home by explaining the role of different organs in the human body.

Special Books

Identifying different books for: Christianity,

Judaism and Sikhism.

- Find similarities and differences within different special books and the messages within them.
- To explain why special books are important to different religions.

You could help your child at home by reading and understanding stories from different special books.

History/Geography

Invaders and Settlers

- Looking at timelines of key events (Anglo -Saxons and Vikings).
- Learning about why people invaded and settled in Britain.
- How transport and trade had an effect the

settlement of the Saxons and Vikings.

You could help your child by researching what life was like at the time of the Saxons.

PE—Dance

- To perform dances using a range of movement patterns.
- To follow steps and build on from movements learnt previously.
- To compare performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement to achieve better results.

You could help your child at home by ensuring they understand different movements when doing physical activities.
